Registration Information

The registration deadline is May 20, 2019 at 1:00 p.m. Registrations will not be processed without a \$50.00 deposit. Please do not hold registrations if you are waiting for third-party funding. In this case, submit registration with third-party funding note on the registration form. The \$50.00 deposit will be reimbursed should the third-party cover the cost of camp in its entirety. Camp Staff

The SRACL Day Camp staff is composed of recreation professionals, educators, teacher's aides, college students studying related fields, and high school students. The camp site has a supervisor who oversees the day-to-day operations of camp with staff who are certified and/or trained in First Aid and CPR.

SRACL's core day camp (Islanders, Explorers, and Troops) is a six week Monday-Thursday camp. The camps will be offered in three, two-week sessions for the convenience of summer planning. This camp will maintain a consistent location, schedule, and staff. Firecrackers Camp, Friday Field Trips, Fridays at Camp, and August Adventures are separate mini camps. Please note the different drop-offs, pick-ups, and locations.
