BEHAVIOR EXPECTATIONS

SRACLCL encourages and promotes the concept of fun for everyone. Certain rules have been established to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all people involved. SRACLCL participants are expected to demonstrate appropriate behavior during programs. SRACLCL's basic behavior code insists that the participants shall:

- Show respect to each other and staff.
- Refrain from using foul or abusive language.
- Refrain from inflicting bodily harm to any individual, including staff.
- Demonstrate respect to equipment and facilities.

A caring and positive approach will be utilized for inappropriate behavior. Individual behavior management plans may be developed on the advice of the parents, guardians, SRACLCL staff, or other professionals. SRACLCL reserves the right to dismiss a participant if noted procedures are not adhered to, and/or, parent/guardian response to a problem situation is not attempted. Each situation will be evaluated individually and on its own merit.

1st offense:

Parents called in regards to a situation, camper removed from camp, meeting set up with Camp Coordinator, parents, and an SRACLCL Administrator.

2nd offense:

Parents called, camper removed from camp, camper suspended from camp for a minimum of one (1) day.

3rd offense:

Parents called, camper removed from camp, camper suspended from camp for a minimum of one (1) week.

4th offense:

Parents called, camper removed from camp, camper suspended from camp for a minimum of one (1) season.



PERSONAL CARE

All participants shall have control over bowel and bladder (diapers and catheters are acceptable). If your child wears diapers, please be sure to send extra diapers, an extra set of clothes, wipes, and anything else they may need.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

New to SRACLCLC? – Here's How to Register

1. Contact the SRACLCLC Office at 847-816-4866 to schedule an Intake Assessment with a recreation professional.**
2. Once completed, SRACLCLC staff will create an online account for you and email your login credentials. You will have 24 hours to accept your account.
3. Visit SRACLCLC.org and click register. Use the login credentials to sign in to your Webtrac account.
4. Select the programs that interest you and add them to your cart.
5. When done selecting programs, check out.

IMPORTANT: Payment for camp will be on a monthly installment bill. All payments for camps starting in June will be processed on June 3. All payments for camps starting in July and August will be processed on July 6. For more details or questions, please contact the SRACLCLC Office at 847-816-4866.
